

ScholarWord v3.0 Release Notes

This release includes the following enhancements:

- 1.) Compatibility with Windows 7
- 2.) Fixed bugs in Word 2007 integration and achieved compatibility with Word 2010
- 3.) Writing and Formatting help for the APA 6th edition
- 4.) Fixed several user interface bugs that occurred on some systems
- 5.) New installers to make Mac/Win installation easier
- 6.) Added a new startup wizard to help setup and pick between writing a paper and just doing a quick bibliography
- 7.) Added a bibliography tool to enter citations and format a bibliography page quickly

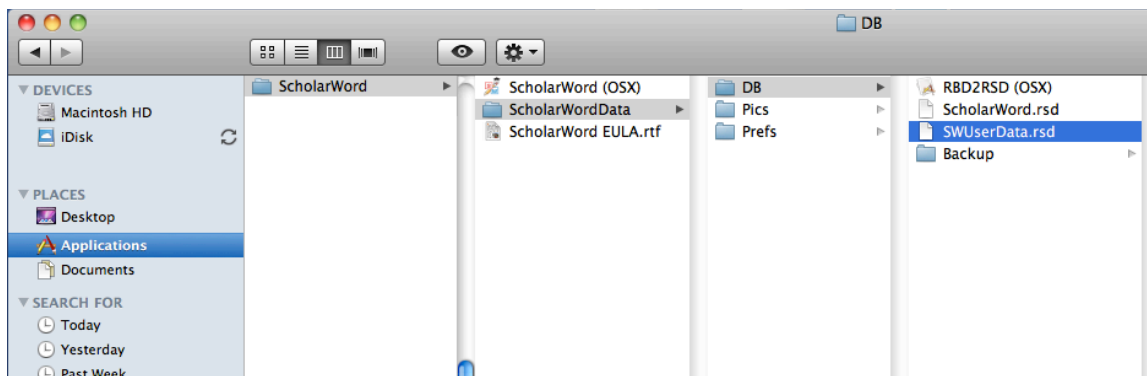
Note: this release only pertains to Mac OS X and Windows builds. We will no longer be supporting Mac Classic or Linux (we might pick Linux back up in the near future).

Upgrade Instructions for Version 3.0

If you are a current ScholarWord user and your version is below 3.0 then you need to complete one simple step to transfer your existing citations and other user data to the new version. To complete this process:

Mac OS X

Step 1: Copy the SWUserData.rsd file from your current ScholarWord folder, for example, ScholarWord-3.0 > ScholarWordData>DB



Step 2: Now, paste that file into the new ScholarWord 3.0 folder:
ScholarWord-3.0>ScholarWordData>DB

Of course you can drag-and-drop too. You will be asked if you want to replace the existing file - click "Ok." You're done!

Windows

Step 1: Copy the SWUserData.rsd file from the folder , for example if you have version 2.2 or lower,

C:\Program Files\Xumbrus\ScholarWord\ScholarWordData\DB

Or if you have version 2.3

C:\Program Files\ScholarWord-3.0\ScholarWordData\DB

Step 2: Now, paste that file into the new ScholarWord 3.0 folder:

C:\Program Files\ScholarWord-3.0\ScholarWordData\DB

You will be asked if you want to replace the existing file - click "Ok." You're done!
